How to Refurbish Patio Table & Chairs

Tools Needed:

- wire brush or sandpaper
- bucket, water, degreasing cleaner (like Simple Green)
- tools to remove table legs (depends on table design)
- 8 cans Rustoleum (color of choice)—will cover 5 chairs, large table, loveseat, and smaller table
- · painters tape and knife for trimming
- newspapers
- bricks/cardboard

Instructions:

- Use wire brush over areas of rust. If necessary, use sandpaper to remove excess rust.
- Use hot water and cleaner to remove dirt, rust flakes, grease, etc. to create a clean surface for painting.
- Carefully remove legs from table tops and store in a safe location.
- Place chairs and table legs on bricks or cardboard to protect surfaces while spraying with paint.
- Use painters tape and newspaper to cover glass table tops.
- Following instructions on paint, spray chairs, table legs, and edge of table tops. Allow to dry completely before reassembling.
- Be sure to clean glass tops on both sides prior to reattaching legs.



TIP: USING AN ATTACHMENT ON THE TOP OF THE PAINT CAN MAKES SPRAYING MUCH EASIER AND MORE EVEN.
